**Flutist Jennifer Rundlett** earned her Masters degree from Peabody Conservatory under Tim Day and studied at the Royal Northern College of Music in England with the famous flute pedagogist Trevor Wye. She is on the faculty of the Frederick Community College and Mount St. Mary's University. She will play music by Amy Beach, Cecil Chaminade and "Castle in the Mist" by Phyllis Avida Louke, using the C flute, the alto flute and the piccolo. Her flute is a Powell gold flute with a platinum riser. **Pianist Li-Ly Chang** is Director of the International Young Artist Piano Competition and commissioned composer in 2011 of the Maryland State Music Teachers Association. **Cellist Laurien Laufman** was hailed by the New York Times as "an artist to watch with a fine blend of technical skill and interpretive insight." She was silver medalist at Villa Lobos International Competition in 1976 and taught at the University of Illinois. She will play "The Suite Populaire Espanole" by Manuel de Falla, then Martinu's "Trio" and Li-Ly Chang's "Fantasia" both for flute, cello and piano.

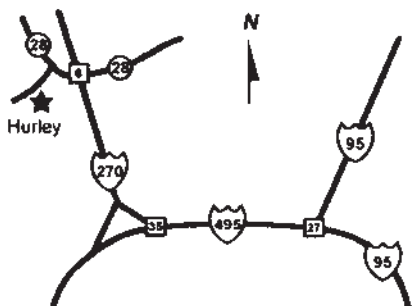
